

How can I apply?

- 1. Please send an e-mail to the Head of Admissions, Prof. (FH) Mag. Roksela Miha (roksela.miha@lbs.ac.at), briefly expressing your interest in applying at LBS
- 2. As a reply to this e-mail you will receive a question. You are kindly asked to answer this question in the form of an essay of 500 words. Please sent the essay in a word format to roksela.miha@lbs.ac.at within 3 working days from the day on which the e-mail was sent
- 3. In case the essay is evaluated positively, you will be kindly asked to submit the complete application package either via e-mail, fax or postal mail
- 4. Once the complete application package has reached the admission office, you will be invited to participate in the Master Assessment which may either take place on campus or via Skype
- 5. In case you have successfully passed the master assessment, you will be informed regarding the admission status via e-mail and receive the official enrolment package to the postal address indicated in your application form

Checklist of the required application documents

- a curriculum vitae
- a copy of birth certificate (to be translated and legally certified in English or German)
- a copy of your citizenship certificate or of your passport
- 1 passport photo (please enclose photo & write your name on the back)
- a copy of your diploma with enclosed transcript of records (list of subjects & respective grades) (to be translated and legally certified in English or German)
- a certificate of English Command (not compulsory but it will be considered by the admission committee) - Cambridge certificate; IELTS; TOEFL
- 2 Reference letters (1 academic reference + 1 non-academic reference)
